Expressive Arts and Design:

To join in with our favourite songs with actions and words.
To explore new sounds, colours and textures!
To use a variety of construction.

Literacy:

To join in singing our favourite rhymes.
To learn about books and read some sight words
To begin to write and draw about our experiences and ideas.
To begin to practise to write our names.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

To play together with our friends responding to them with words and actions.
To use our words when we want to share something.
To solve small problems.
To take turns and to share.

Understanding the World:

To notice what is around us at home, in school and in Bethnal Green.
To explore different textures and colours and talk about what we notice.
To use simple ICT equipment.

This is what we are learning at school!

Communication and Language:

To listen carefully and play with sounds.
To understand and talk in sentences.
To use talk to explain how we feel, what we are doing and to share our ideas.
To have conversations and listen to what other people say.
To use position words to say where things are.

Maths:

To recognise numbers 1 - 10.
To count a small number of objects.
To use words about time and money.
To put numbers in order.
To compare lengths.
To investigate and talk about shapes using words like 'round'



Physical development:

To use the toilet independently and to remember to wash our hands.
To use tools like scissors carefully.
To move confidently in lots of different ways.
To try different foods.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- ☐ Sing simple songs together.
- ☐ Paint, draw, stick and cut pictures.
- ☐ Talk about how different things feel.
- ☐ Find new ways to make noise!

Physical development:

- ☐ Encourage your child to use one-handed tools to feed themselves.
- ☐ Encourage your child to use the toilet independently.
- ☐ Go to the play park together.
- ☐ Keep trying new foods.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- ☐ Talk through any arguments explaining how to solve them.
- ☐ Encourage your child to use their words to say what they feel, need and want.

Understanding the World:

- ☐ Talk about the area we live in, what can they see, hear and smell?
- ☐ Talk about how “people help us” such as fire people, doctors, nurses, dentists, police and para-medics.



These are ideas of how you can help your child extend their learning at

Communication and Language:

- ☐ **TALK with** your child about their interests.
- ☐ Encourage your child to use sentences not just single words by repeating back what they say in a sentence.
- ☐ Ask them to get things that are on top, under, next to or behind other things.
- ☐ Talk together about everything!

Maths:

- ☐ Count anything!
- ☐ Talk about the shape of objects.
- ☐ Talk about the time of day, hours, minutes, days, months etc
- ☐ Organise things into longest and shortest.
- ☐ Do puzzles together.
- ☐ Encourage girls and boys to do lego and construction toys to support their maths.



Literacy:

- ☐ Go to the Idea Store library to borrow books.
- ☐ Read street signs to your child
- ☐ Model writing such as cards, lists - shopping.
- ☐ Look at books together.
- ☐ Read and practice the sight words that will be sent home.
- ☐ Practice writing their name.
